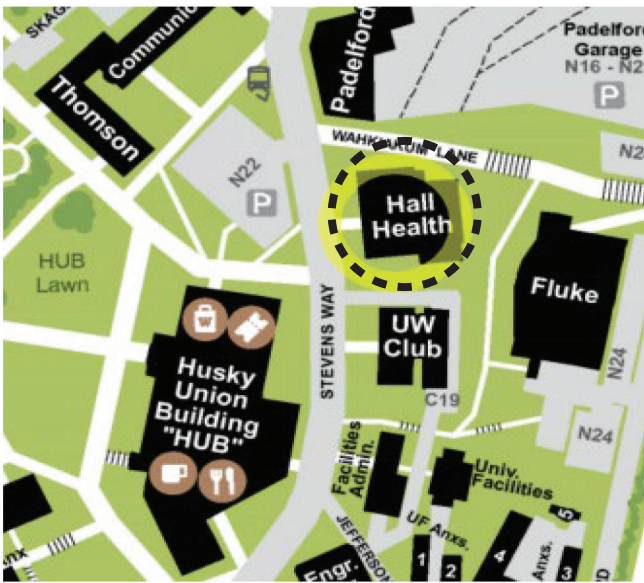

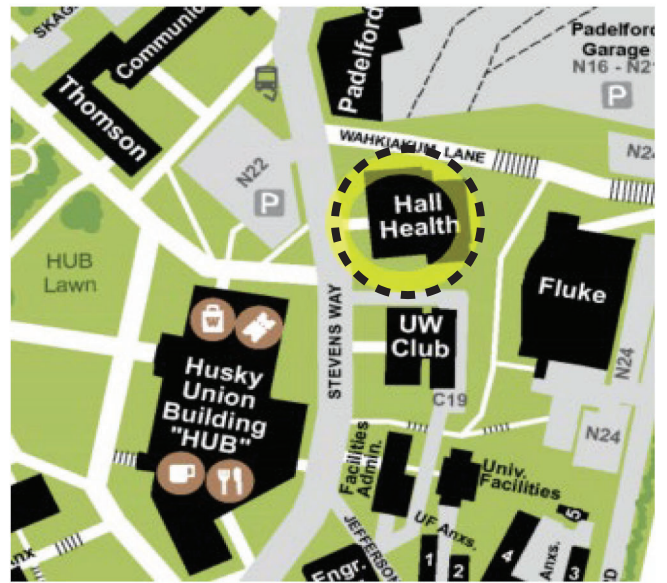

DIY: How to Make an Appointment

Checklist before calling:

Be ready to share the following information before calling the scheduler:

- ✓ Student ID number
- ✓ Full name
- ✓ Date of birth
- ✓ *If you have health insurance, have that information ready as well.*

Call Hall Health Center: 206-616-2495 Introduce yourself to the scheduler.

Let them know you are a UW Seattle incoming or current student.

- Provide information to the scheduler when asked.

Share the reason for your visit.

- Request an appointment to receive your UW required vaccines of either Measles and Mumps (MMR), Meningitis ACWY, or COVID-19; or to have lab blood work (Measles and Mumps titers)
- Pick a time slot or date that works for you
- *If you do not have insurance, ask for vaccine pricing and be prepared to pay out of pocket.*

Confirm your scheduled appointment.

- Save the date into your calendar.
- Provide your phone number for confirmation and follow-up.

Come to your Appointment!

- Arrive at Hall Health Center at least 10 minutes before your appointed time.
- If you have previous immunization records in your physical possession, bring them with you to your appointment.
- Bring your ID and Husky Card
- *If you have insurance, please bring your insurance card as well.*

DIY: How to Make an Appointment

Checklist before calling:

Be ready to share the following information before calling the scheduler:

- ✓ Student ID number
